<p>Admission Requirements for the Program:</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The student must hold a bachelor's degree with a satisfactory cumulative grade point average (GPA) or a grade of D, preceded by a high school diploma in science (science or mathematics) or its equivalent (from within or outside the Arab Republic of Egypt). according to the rules and regulations set by the Supreme Council of Universities. 2. The student's first foreign language must be English. 3. The student must pass the entrance exams. 4. The student must pass the medical examination and tests. 5. The student must pass all qualifying courses for one semester (preparatory) for a period of 15 weeks in order to join the program if he did not study them in the first university stage or in general secondary science mathematics, where the student must register for the biology course in the preparatory semester (3 hours). 6. Students who fail any of the preparatory courses in the preparatory semester are allowed to retake the exam once before the start of the first semester. If they fail again, they must register for the failed courses, retake them, and be examined in them. If they fail for the third time, they will be dismissed.
