

Overview of Accelerated bachelor of Nursing Sciences Program (Credit Hours System)

❖ Program Duration:

24 months (six semesters without breaks) plus a 12-month mandatory internship period

❖ Program Credit Hours:

- Completion of a total of (140) credit hours, including all registered courses, equivalent to (122) hours, plus (18) credit hours taken in the preparatory semester
- Completion of a 12-month mandatory internship period, equivalent to 12 credit hours, or 36 actual hours per week

❖ Program Description:

- The program helps university graduates with a Bachelor's degree to change their career path to nursing and obtain a university degree in nursing (Bachelor of Science in Nursing).
- Qualifying graduates from other fields to secure excellent job opportunities at the national, regional, and international levels.
- Addressing the nursing shortage relative to the population
- Helping to solve the unemployment problem and opening new fields of innovative nursing programs.

❖ Program Admission Requirements:

- A bachelor's degree with a satisfactory cumulative GPA or (D) proceeded by a high school diploma in science (science or mathematics) or its equivalent (inside or outside the Arab Republic of Egypt).
- English must be the first foreign language.
- Passing the entrance exams and passing the medical examination.
- Passing all preparatory courses for one semester (preliminary) of 15 weeks to enroll in the program if they were not studied in their undergraduate studies or in high school (science/mathematics). Students must register for the biology course (3 credit hours) in the preparatory semester.
- Students who fail any of the preparatory courses in the preparatory semester are allowed to retake the exam once before the start of the first semester. If they fail again, they must register for, retake, and re-examine the failed courses. A third failure will result in dismissal.
